# EUSALP Action Group 6: Policy Recommendations



## Sustainable land use and soil protection

**Political Declaration, 20 Alpine Regions and 6 Alpine States commit to:**

- Apply and enhance the **implementation of existing regulations on sustainable land use and soil protection**
- Coordinate and improve **data collection** and **monitoring systems**
- Foster **inner-urban development** and **plan infrastructure** and **mining** prudently
- Encourage awareness raising, capacity building and experience exchange
- Facilitate and live **participation**
- Establish and strengthen regional, national and cross-border **co-operations**

# EUSALP Action Group 6

## Policy Recommendations



### Preservation of Alpine landscapes in times of climate crisis and renewable energy production

- **Transform energy sector** from fossil-based to zero-carbon: quick phasing out of fossil fuels, urgent actions from global to local level
- Take **hard decisions** concerning **future landscapes, biodiversity loss and renewables** with **political will** for implementation
- Effectively **integrate mitigation and adaptation actions** into sectoral activities and avoid lock-in effects through **spatial planning**
- Combine top-down approach with bottom-up elements and strive for **multi-functional solutions** in **spatial planning** (e.g. agrivoltaics)
- **Save energy** and **expand renewable energy production** simultaneously
- Acknowledge **limits of growth**

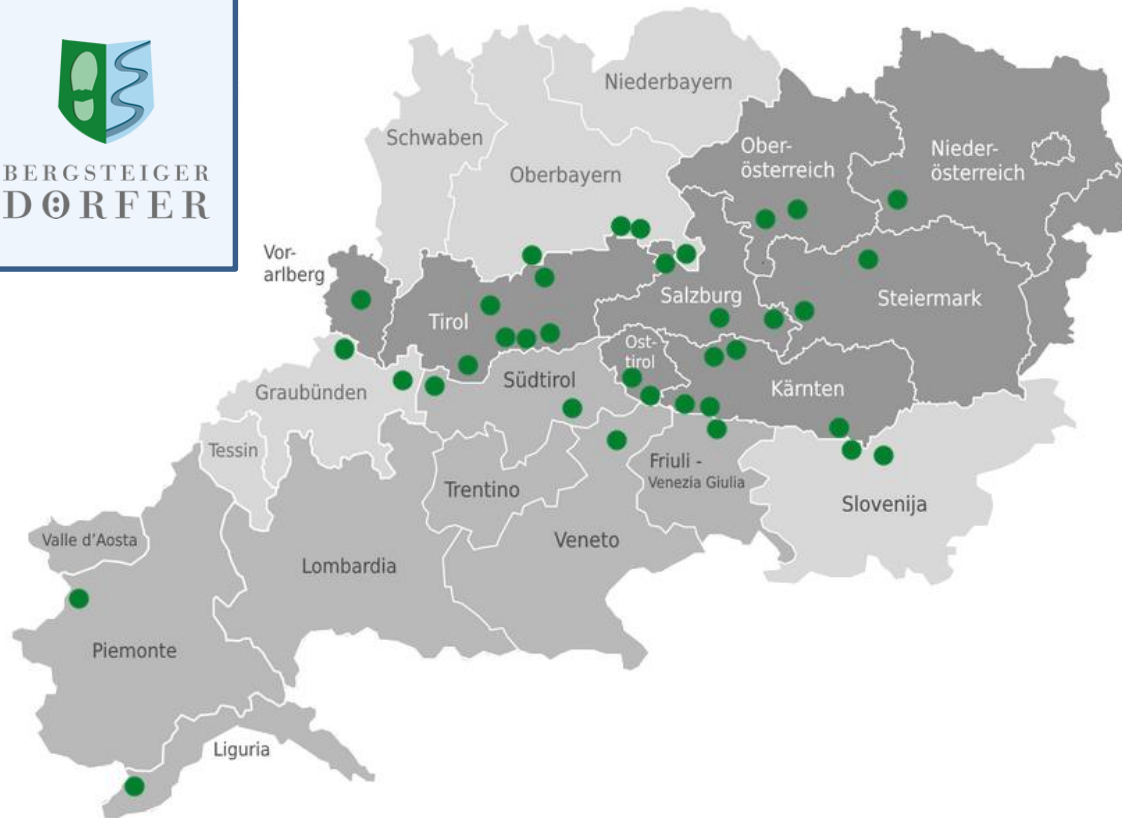
