### UNIMONT: International Master's Degree students attend the EUSALP Action Group 1 meeting

On Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> February, the students of the International Master's degree course in "Valorization and Sustainable Development of Mountain Areas" attended the meeting of Action Group 1 - Research & Innovation - of EUSALP, - European Strategy for the Alpine Region, a process involving 7 states, 48 regions and the European Commission.


The European kick-off meeting for the AgrifoodTEF project was held in Povo (TN) at the Bruno Kessler foundation. Coordinated by the latter, the project has received funding worth 60 million euros (50% from the European Union and the other half from Member States) to be managed in 5 years. Over 3 million euros will be received by the Milan section represented by prof. Davide Facchinetti of UNIMONT and by prof. Matteo Matteucci of the Polytechnic University of Milan.

### 16th March 2023 | Youth4Mountains Series : Alpine mountain environments; a climate-sensitive fragile ecosystem - Gaurav Kumar, UNIMONT student

Climate change has a cascading impact on alpine mountain environments. The diverse aspects of mountain environments such as glaciers, rivers, biodiversity, agroecosystems, humans and urban settlements are vulnerable to climate alterations.
