UNIMONT and the Lombardy Region: an agreement for the valorization of mountain territories

The Regional Council of Lombardy has approved a resolution with the aim of supporting and promoting knowledge of the Bachelor's degree course in "Development and Protection of the Mountain Environment" and of the international master's degree in "Valorization and Sustainable Development of Mountain Areas", as well as the UNIMONT center of the University of Milan.

AGRITECH

Agritech – the National Centre for Agricultural Technologies is a national project financed with NRRP funds that involves 28 universities, 5 research centres, and 18 companies. The UNIMONT centre of the University of Milan will operate within Spoke 7, focusing on mountain areas with the aim of promoting a multifunctional production system that favours the agro-ecological and socio-economic sustainability of these territories.

Contribute to the mapping of Italian plant agro-biodiversity: report local varieties in your area

UNIMONT, a Centre of the University of Milan, is mapping and characterizing traditional Italian local varieties through a citizen science activity, i.e. involving citizens in the collection of scientific data in order to integrate the map of Italian plant agro-biodiversity. This initiative is supported by the NRRP Agritech project - National Center for Agricultural Technologies.

4th April 2024 | Presentazione del Primo Villaggio degli Alpinisti di Regione Lombardia: LOZIO

Lozio, a small and enchanting village located in Lombardy, has recently been recognised as the 'Mountaineers' Village', becoming the first in Lombardy and the sixth in Italy. The village of Lozio stands out for its tourist offer focused on the quality of the landscape and the sustainable development of the area.

10th April 2024 | VALUTAZIONE DELL'EVOLUZIONE DELLE PRATERIE SUBALPINE DELLA VALCAMONICA ASSOCIATA AL CAMBIAMENTO DELL'USO DEL SUOLO

Alpine pastures and meadows are agroecosystems of ecological and landscape importance, protected by the European Union. In recent decades, grassland areas have declined rapidly due to changes in management and/or the abandonment of traditional mountain agriculture in the Alps. During the seminar, the results of a study aimed at characterising the relationship between historical and current management of subalpine grasslands, their plant diversity, soil properties and humus forms will be described.

18th April 2024 | I VALORI DI FONDO NATURALE PER L'ARSENICO NEI SUOLI E NEI TERRENI DELL'ALTA VALLE CAMONICA: L'APPLICAZIONE NELLA GESTIONE DELLE TERRE E ROCCE DA SCAVO E NELLA BONIFICA DEI SITI CONTAMINATI

The soils of the Alpine and pre-alpine areas of Lombardy are characterised, in a widespread manner, by the presence of arsenic of natural origin in concentrations above the legal limits. In contexts such as these, current legislation assigns the Environmental Protection Agencies the competence for defining the background values to be used to assess the environmental quality of a soil. The definition of background values is particularly useful in the management of excavated soils and rocks, in accordance with the provisions of Presidential Decree 120/2017, as it makes it possible not to initiate the reclamation procedure and to use the excavated soils as a by-product even in sites other than the production site as long as they have background values comparable to those in the area of origin. ARPA of Lombardy in collaboration with the Comunità Montana di Valle Camonica carried out a study to define the natural background values for arsenic in the soils of the municipalities of Corteno Golgi, Edolo, Incudine, Malonno, Monno, Ponte di Legno, Sonico, Temù, Vezza D'Oglio and Vione. The conference is an opportunity to present the results of the work carried out and to illustrate how the background values determined in the context of the management of excavated soil and rocks and reclamation procedures can be applied.

23rd April 2024 | MAPPE DI VARIABILITÀ DELLE AZIENDE DI MONTAGNA PER IL MANAGEMENT CON DIGITAL FARMING

The technologies currently available, applied to agricultural machinery, enable performance and ways of farming that were not applicable before. Digital Farming, which refers to the use of digital technologies to improve the efficiency and productivity of agriculture, through the collection, storage and processing of data, also enables prerequisites for product traceability, thus enhancing supply chains and contributing to greater consumer guarantees. At the basis of production processes, variability maps represent the first awareness for the application of precision farming strategies, also in mountain farms, the starting point for management with Digital Farming.
